## **Course Description: High-Quality Matters: Training Your Team**

This course is designed for special education directors, special education consulting teachers and special education teacher-leaders that would like to increase their knowledge and skills in developing high-quality professional development. Participants will learn the critical components of developing learning environments for adult learners.
